Shotgun Training and Winchester Qualification Program

You asked for it and we started it the winter of 2022. This year we will be training over 50 participants with the FirstSteps Shotgun and the Basic Shotgun courses. Currently we have several Instructors ready to take the challenge. We will be conducting the classes at the Education Center then go do shooting a the newly built youth shotgun shooting area adjacent to the 50 yrd range. The cost for the FirstSteps program is going to be around \$35 which will include use of our shotguns, ammo and clay targets.

Our athletes compete in a center fire and/or a rim fire division.


Targets are steel circle or rectangular plate's.

All courses of fire are timed events.

- 1. Rim fire (Junior Varsity) squads are organized based on the same age groups as Center fire (Varsity):
- Junior Division (ages 12 16),
- 3. Senior (17 20)
- 4. Collegiate (no age limit). In the event a squad has both Junior and Senior Division members, in order to complete a squad the entire squad will be required to compete in the Senior Division.
